	<u>Poultry Discussion</u> : Director Arrington stated that she has been approached by residents regarding allowing residents to raise poultry for their eggs. If this is to move forward it will require a change to the District's Covenants by a vote of all residents.

	<u>Approval of January 2023 Claims:</u> Mr. Schlegel presented a list of current claims for the Board's consideration. After review Director Arrington moved that the Board approve the claims presented for payment totaling \$6.029.38 represented by checks #1199 through #1208. Upon a second by Director Reed a vote

was taken, and the motion carried unanimously.
